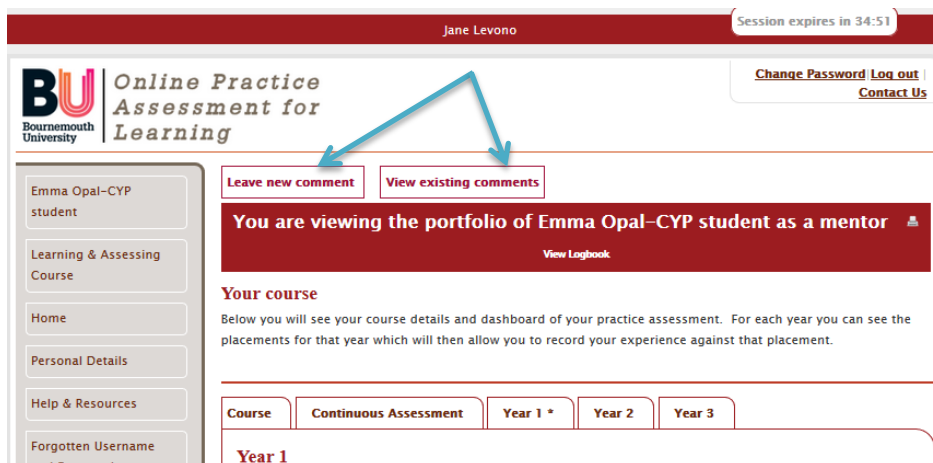


How to create leave a comment in OPAL (Practice assessor/supervisor).

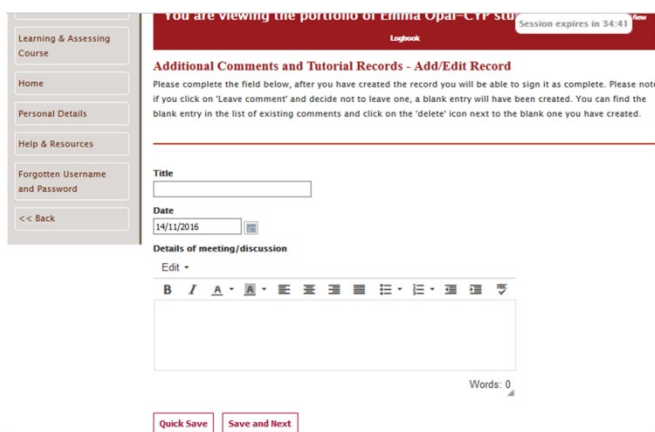
There may be occasions when as a practice assessor/supervisor you wish to record something in one of your students OPAL PAT but it is not the right time for an interview. There is a very simple facility to add a comment which is recorded in OPAL and can be viewed by the student, other practice assessors/supervisors and the academic assessor. This facility can be used to leave positive feedback for example commendation from the team on excellent performance or feedback from service users. It can also be used to record details of a conversation or interview to give feedback and guidance.

When you log in as practice assessor/supervisor and select your student you will see on the dashboard the options to **'Leave new comment'** or **'view existing comments'**.

NB-Please note that "mentor" in the below screenshots is to be replaced by Practice Assessor/Supervisor



View existing comments: by clicking on this button you will see comments previously left. If nothing appears this means, there are no comments to view!



Leave new comment: by clicking on this button a new window will open which allows a title to be added and a box to type in. This box will also allow you to cut and paste from another document and this is a useful facility if you wish to take time constructing the entry.

Once the entry is added and spell checked there are two options, to **'Quick save'** which saves the comment but allows you to edit later or to **'Save and next'** which takes

you to the page to sign the entry. Once the entry is signed it cannot be changed.
